#### Procurement Bill



#### s.12: Procurement Objectives

- "In carrying out a covered procurement, contracting authorities <u>must have regard to</u> the importance of [...] <u>maximising public benefit</u>"
- Lord True: 'public benefit' is "how public money can achieve additional benefit in the way that the contract is delivered, which would include how to maximise social value".

#### s.13: The national procurement policy statement

- National procurement statement will set out the Government's "strategic priorities in relation to procurement".
- "A contracting authority <u>must have regard to</u> the national procurement policy statement".
